

The Anointed Constitution of the Sovereign Land of Apartment 106

Preamble: We The People Of The Apartment 106, In Order To Form A More Perfect Coalition, Establish Justice, Insure Domestic Tranquility Of All Williamsburg, Provide For The Common Defense, And Secure The Blessings Of Liberty To Ourselves And Our Use Of Firearms, Do Ordain And Establish This Anointed Constitution For The Sovereign Land Of Apartment 106.

1st Amendment: A Member Is Defined In One Of Three Ways: An In-House Member Is One Who Currently Resides And Pays Rent In Apartment 106. An Out-Of-House Member Is One Who Was At A Point In Time An In-House Member. An Honorary Member Is One, Who By The Unanimous Vote Of All Members, Is Chosen.

2nd Amendment: All New Members Will Be Inducted By A Ceremonial Meal At The Spaghetti Warehouse, Where The Majority of Members Must Be Present. This Will Be Consummated By A Battle Of Air-Soft Guns At Night's End.

3rd Amendment: Membership Is A Lifelong Title And All Members Hold A Key For Right Of Passage Into 106. One Cannot Renounce Or Have His/Her Membership Revoked. Forever Be The Brand Upon Thy Soul Of Apartment 106.

4th Amendment: Live In Guests Exceeding The 4 Person Standard Will Pay A Portion Of Rent If One Resides On The Large Couch (\$100), Small Couch (\$60), Medium Couch (\$80), In The Guest Bed Room (under the Ping-Pong Table - \$100). Rent for Invisibility Portal is a one-time fee of \$20.

5th Amendment: All New Guests Must Recite The Following: "Apartment 106 Is Not Responsible For Any Bodily Injuries Which Can And Probably Will Occur During My Visit Here. I Am Aware That My Death Potential Has Increased 3 Fold And Hold No Reservations In Any Future Liability Against Apartment 106.

6th Amendment: All Members' Mothers Must Adhere To The Cleanliness Law Upon Their Combat Boots. If Thy Mother Trice Refuse To Maintain Said Combat Boots Clean, Her Son Or Daughter Shall Take Her Punishment In Her Stead.

Article I (The Commandments Of All Members)

Section:

1. Thou Shall Do All Thy Appointed Chores Every Week (Or Close Enough)
2. Thou Shall Pay Thy Rent If Ye Is An In-House Member In A Timely Manner (Elasticity Of "Timely" Decided By Current In-House Accountant)
3. Thou Shall Adhere To The Cost Of Living Which Are To Be Decided By In House Accountant
4. Thou Shall Not Eat Single Serve Meal Which Does Not Belong To Thyself
5. Thou Shall Be Present And On Time For Every Battle Or Must Give Prior Notice For Tardiness Or Absenteeism
6. Thou Shall Not Allow Potatoes To Rot In Thy Kitchen

Article II (The Conduct of Battling)

Section:

1. All Participants And Non-Combatants In The Battlefield Must Wear Eye Protection
2. No Intentional Aiming At The Face Of An Opponent Or Teammate
3. All Weapons Which Have Been Deemed "Illegal" By The Majority Of All 106 Members Can Never Be Used On Anyone Without Their Consent Except For Use In Firing Squad
4. Conditions Of Victory Must Be Declared Prior or During A Battle And Must Be Agreed Upon By Majority Of Both Sides
5. In A Sniper Game, All Persons Must Take An Oath To Be Truthful When Shot By An Opponent.
6. In A Sniper Game, Only The Initial Impact Of A Pellet Matters

7. A Kill Is Defined In A Sniper Game When A Pellet Hits An Opponent Anywhere, Even The Brim Of Their Hat
8. All First Time Guests Must Be Trained On Use Of Air-Soft Guns By A Member Of 106 Before Allowed To Battle

Article III (Miscellaneous Games)

Section:

1. All New Guests Participating In The Invisibility Game Must Remain In Living Room While Judah Makes His Venture Into The Dark Unknown
2. All Persons Who Have Already Gained Knowledge Of The Invisibility Game Must Steadfastly Hold The Secret From All New Participants
3. All Standard Rules For Ping-Pong Apply; In Addition, Any unintentional Shots Off The Wall, Ceiling Or Fan Are Good So Long As The Ball Hits The Opponents Side Upon Landing
4. No Standard Ping-Pong Rules Apply For Crazy Ping-Pong Doubles
5. All Persons Are Limited To Carrying One (Maybe More With General Approval) Weapon While Playing Ping-Pong
6. Indoor Archery Must Take Place In A Cleared Area With Complete Certainty That The Arrows Will Fly Straight
7. Ninja Star Throwing (See Art. III Sec. 6)
8. When chosen to be shot by the shotgun, the recipient must be 100% sure of the loaded shell.
9. All Other Weapons Are To Be Used In A Manner Which The Death Potential Is Less Than Or Equal To 10% (Death Potential To Be Assessed By The Safety Inspector)
10. Death Potential Is Always Determined By The Safety Inspector

Article IV (Judicial Review)

Section:

1. All Persons Who Are Accused Of Transgression Of The Law Must Be Motioned And Seconded To Judicial Review Only By Members Of 106.
2. Prosecution Of Defending Party Is Comprised Of The Two Members Whom Bring Charges Against The Defendant
3. Defendant Is Not Required An Attorney, However, Any Member Or Non-Member May Defend Him/Her In The Judicial Review
4. Prosecution And Defense Is Not Allowed To Vote "Guilty" Or "Not Guilty"
5. All Members Hold Equal Voting Weight In Judicial Review
6. Decision Is Made When A Majority Of Present Members, With A Minimum Jury Of 3 Members, Cast A Similar Vote

Article V (Punishment)

Section:

1. All Punishment Is Defaulted To The Firing Squad
2. Firing Squad Is To Be Held When Majority Of Members Are Present
3. All Air-Soft Firearms Are Legal
4. Alternate Forms Of Punishment Must Be Decided At Close Of Judicial Review
5. All Persons Hereby Named Patrick McBride Will Not Receive Judicial Review If Motion Of Transgression Is Seconded, But Will Receive Firing Squad Without Trial
