Began his Police Career in April 1966, serving in the Patrol Division, Detective in the Crimes Against Person Division and as an Investigator in the Dallas County District Attorney's Office. After retiring from the Dallas Police Department, worked in private sector as Corporate Security Director. In Aug of 1998, joined Dallas County Constable Office and served in every capacity; civil, warrant and writ enforcement. During all of this time also serving in the Army Reserve, retiring in 2004 at the rank of Colonel after 41 years of service. Was also the first ever non-physician Commander of an Army Hospital. Graduated with Honors from Sam Houston State University with a BS in Criminology and Corrections and also graduating from the Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, KS. Elected Constable of Dallas County Precinct 3 in 2006 and sworn into Office on January 1st, 2007.
